Visiting the homes of James Madison, Thomas Jefferson, and James Monroe provides a unique and enriching experience that connects visitors to the lives of three of the most influential figures in early American history. Each home offers insights into their personal lives, political philosophies, and legacies, as well as the complex history of the United States.

### Day 1, Thursday, September 11, 2025

### Day 2, Friday September 12, 2025

Enjoy **BREAKFAST** at your hotel before checking out. We begin our day at **THOMAS JEFFERSON'S, MONTICELLO** a historic plantation home of the third President of the United States, located near Charlottesville, Virginia. It sits atop a hill and is renowned for its neoclassical architectural style, which Jefferson personally designed. The name "Monticello" is derived from the Italian word for "little mountain," reflecting its location on an elevated ridge. The house is a blend of Jefferson's vision, incorporating elements of Palladian architecture and classical design. It features a distinctive dome on the roof, symmetrical facades, and open spaces, all designed with Jefferson's emphasis on both beauty and functionality. The interior is equally remarkable, with rooms showcasing a mix of European

and American styles, reflecting Jefferson's intellectual interests and his role as a statesman. The surrounding grounds at Monticello include meticulously designed gardens, orchards, and a working farm, all integral to Jefferson's vision of self-sufficiency. The plantation was also the site of slavery, with Jefferson owning hundreds of enslaved individuals over the years, and their lives and labor played a significant role in maintaining Monticello. <u>https://www.monticello.org</u>

One of Charlottesville's unknowns is the **ROTUNDA AT THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA**, which is a must for anyone interested in American history, architecture, and the legacy of Thomas Jefferson. The Rotunda, designed by Jefferson himself, is the centerpiece of the University of Virginia campus and holds deep historical and cultural significance. The Rotunda is one of the most iconic neoclassical buildings in America, symbolizing the ideals of knowledge and reason. It draws inspiration from the Roman Pantheon and reflects Jefferson's admiration for classical architecture and Enlightenment ideals.
